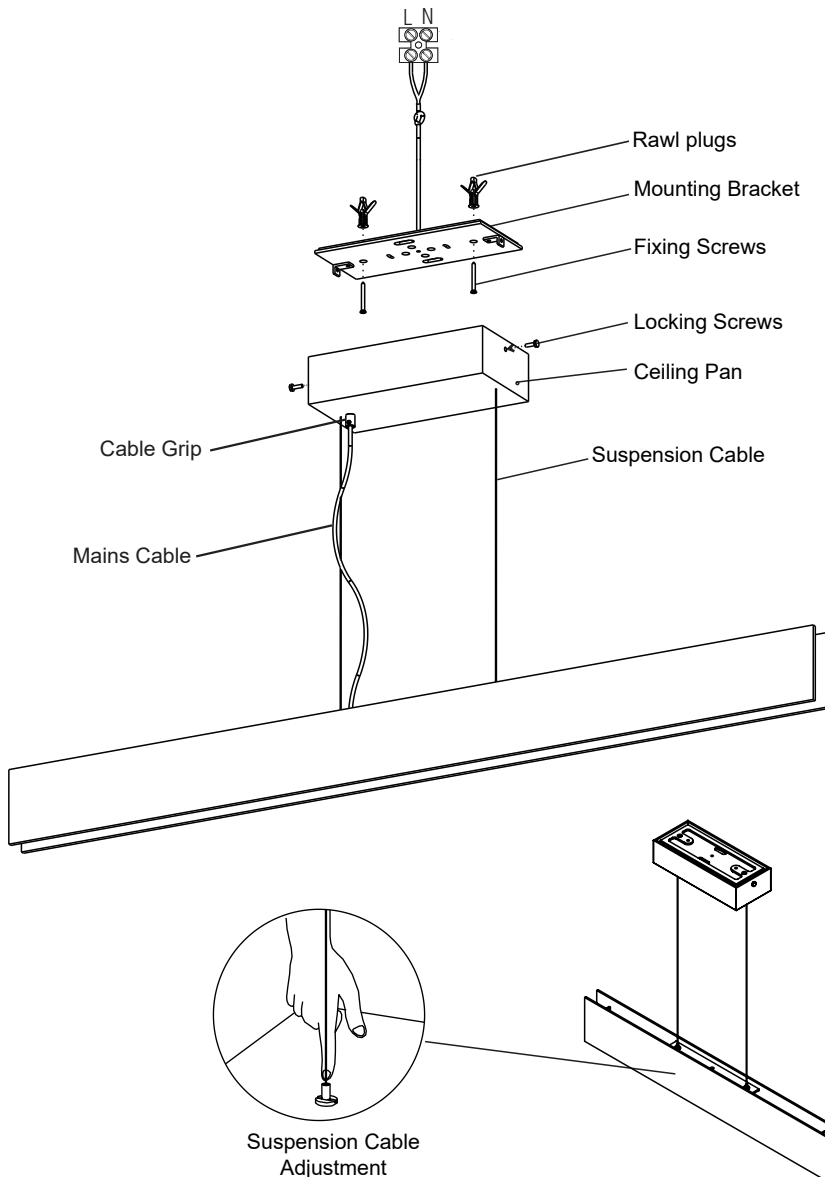

**ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS  
QN-CLEAN-LED-LP-127-TEAK**

1. Turn power off.
2. Remove locking screws from the ceiling pan.
3. Install suitable (provided) rawl plugs (or your preferred fixings) into the ceiling using the mounting bracket as a template.
4. Install the mounting bracket to the ceiling using the provided screws (or your preferred fixings).
5. Feed the mains cable through the cable grip on the ceiling pan to required length.
6. Feed the two thin suspension cables through the suspension cable adjustments on the light body and adjust to required length.
7. Offer ceiling pan to mounting bracket adjusting mains cable and suspension cables to required drop length.
8. Make electrical connections.
9. Tighten cable grip with small flat-head screwdriver (do not over tighten).
10. Install the locking screws.
11. Turn power on.



Note: This fitting uses a LED light source built into the unit
